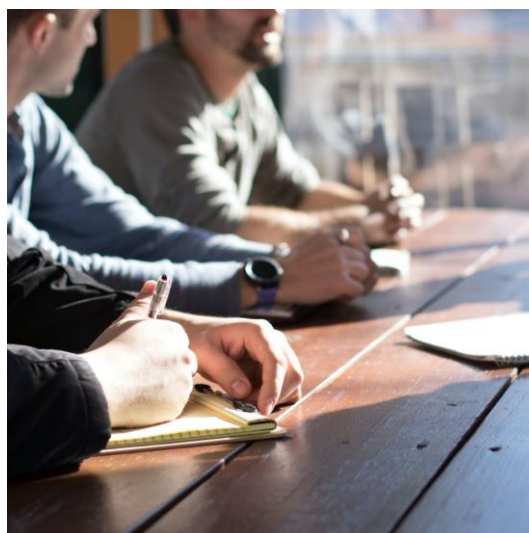


Prospering Boards open for applications

Governance case study - Ilfracombe Museum

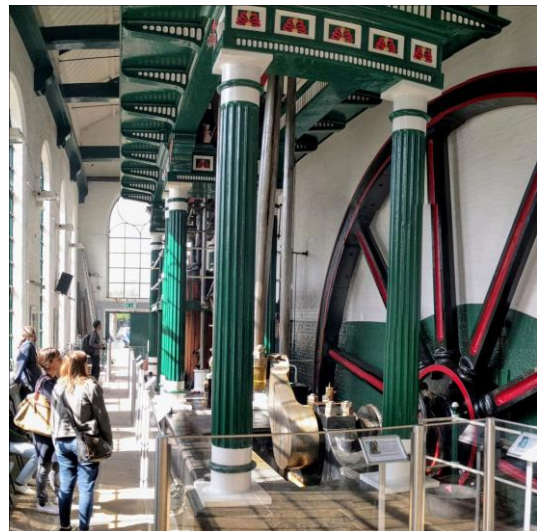
